My Adventure made this fourth day of
 September Eighteen hundred and Seventeen
 between Dicy Lindsey of the state of Georgia and
 County of Wilkes of the one part and Joseph
 Pullin of the same state and County of the other
 part. Witnesseth that the said Dicy Lindsey
 for and in consideration of the sum of One
 hundred dollars to me in hand paid by the
 said Joseph Pullin the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged have bargained and sold and by
 these presents do bargain sell and confirm unto
 the said Joseph Pullin his heirs and assigns forever
 being distributive part of a tract of land on
 the waters of Pistol Creek in the County of
 Wilkes containing two hundred Acres more
 or less being the tract of land whereon Dicy
 Lindsey did formerly live and do warrant and
 vend the same from all persons unto the
 said Joseph Pullin his heirs and assigns forever
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal the day and date first above
 written. The words or ones to the part crossed
