 Wilkes County ³ twelfth of November One thousand Eight
 hundred and Twenty seven Between Thomas Lunday acting
 agent of Archibald Lunday of Clark County alias an
 State and William Pool of Wilkes County and State of Georgia
 Witness that I have this day Bargained sold released and
 confirmed unto the said William Pool his heirs and assigns all
 that tract or parcel of land being the Distributors share of
 a tract of Land formerly belonging to Elijah Lunday
 deceased of Wilkes County & State of Georgia joining Sarah
 Stokes and other lying on Postal course being the part that
 may hereafter fall to the said Archibald Lunday to have
 and to hold unto the said William Pool his heirs and assigns forever
 for the consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty
 Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged do for ever warrant hold and defend unto
 of Land as aforesaid unto him the said William Pool his
 heirs and assigns forever in fee simple.
