Stephenson's house, where he was put in the meat house and tied to the back of Edmond Lindsey.

Lindsey was put into a meat house where he was tied to the back of William Crew. Lindsey said that he was next taken to Stewart's Crossing. Along the way Col. John Stephenson beat Edmond with his gun. Lindsey was court-martialed and sentenced to serve a term in the VA militia even though he was already serving as a soldier in the PA militia.
