and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land as
above stated. I do hereby grant and convey all my rights
title & Claim to the above mentioned tract of Land
to my said beloved Daughter Anna as aforesaid her heirs
and assigns forever in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this second day of March one
thousand eight hundred & twenty two

This Indenture made the 29th day of January in the Year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty two & in the forty
sixth year of the Independence of the United States of America
between John S. Hester of the County of Wilkes & State aforesaid
& State aforesaid of the other part Wilkes & State aforesaid
on the one part & Dennis Dent of the County of Columbus
& State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said
John S. Hester for & in Consideration of the sum of thirty two
hundred & forty four Dollars to him in hand well and truly
paid the said Dennis Dent at or before the Sealing & delivery
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
has granted, bargained, sold, released & confirmed, and by these presents
doth he grant bargain, sell, release and confirm unto the said
Dennis Dent his heirs & assigns, all that tract or parcel of
Land situate lying & being in the County of Wilkes aforesaid
containing five hundred forty four acres more or less ad-
joining Lands of John Peckham Lacey George Deacons &
others it being part of two surveys are granted to Price
Collins and am to Peckham. Witness & the balance given
