 bargained and sold and by these presents do grant  
 bargain sell unto Elijah Pullin his heirs and assigns  
 a certain dividend or parcel of Land, situate in said  
 County on the waters of Pistol Creek containing Twenty Six &  
 a half acres (more or less) known as the land which Thomas  
 Dudley Sen Decr - which said Land is a Distributive  
 part or Legacy of Elizabeth Lindsey together with all and  
 singular the appurtenances thereto belonging which

 defend against the claim of the persons whatsoever unto
