This Indenture Made this fourthth 18
day of September in the year of our
Lord Eighteen hundred and Seventeen
Between James Lindsey of the State of
Georgia and County of Wilkes of the One
part and Joseph Pullin of the same State
and County of the other part. Witnesseth
that the said James Lindsey for and in
consideration of the sum of One Hundred dol-
lars to me in hand paid by the said Joseph
Pullin the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained and sold and by these presents
do bargain sell and confirm unto the said
Joseph Pullin his heirs and assigns forever all
my distributive part of a tract of land on the
waters of Pilot Creek in the County aforesaid
containing two hundred Acres More or less
being the tract of land whereon Elijah Lindsey
deceased formerly lived and do warrant and defend
the same from all persons unto the said
Joseph Pullin his heirs and assigns forever
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal the day and date first above
written. The words on one sixth part read
