of February in the year of our said Eighteen
Hundred and Seventeen Between John
Lindsey of the State of Georgia and County
of Wilkes of the one part and Joseph
Pullen of the same State and County of
the other part. Witnesseth that the said
John Lindsey for and in Consideration of the
sum of One Hundred Dollars to Me in hand
paid by the said Joseph Pullen the Receipt whereof
I hereby Acknowledged have bargained and
sold and by these presents do bargain sell and
convey unto the said Joseph Pullen his
heirs and assigns forever all my substitutive
part of a tract of land and the waters of
Pilot's Creek in the County aforesaid
containing two hundred and five Acres
more or less being the tract of land
whereon Elijah Lindsey died formerly lived
and do warrant and defend the same from
the present unto the said Joseph Pullen
his heirs and assigns forever. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
unto the day and date first above written
the words or one Sixth part thereof before
signed
