 the County & State aforesaid of the one part and Elijah Pullin
 of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mary
 Lindsey for herself and acting agent for her three Daugh-
 ters (viz) Charlotte Lindsey, Rhoda Lindsey & Mary
 Lindsey Minors for and in consideration of the sum of
 One hundred and sixty Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and
 released and conveyed & by these presents granted bargained and
 sold unto the said Elijah Pullin his heirs and assigns
 a certain divided of parcel of Land being and being
 in the State and County & State aforesaid in the Tracts of
 Pistol Creek containing ninety acres more or less known
 as the land whereon Thomas Lindsey Senr Dier, which land
 is the Dispositum part or parts or Equies of Mary Lindsey
 for herself and acting agent for her three Daughters
 (viz) Charlotte Lindsey Rhoda Lindsey & Mary Lindsey
 Minors) do warrant and defend from the claim of all
 persons the above stated Land unto Elijah Pullin his
 heirs and assigns forever.
