part Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of forty
one Dollars to him in hand paid the receipt hereof is acknowledged
in full by this present Bargain, sell & Confirm unto the aforesaid
Elijah Pullen his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of
land being & lying in the State & County aforesaid containing
twenty five Acres more or less which is known as said Lindsey part
of the lot of land on which Thomas Lindsey his Father dwelt
to have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land together with
all & singular the rights, members & appurtenances whatsover
unto the said Elijah Pullen his heirs & assigns to his & their posterity
in full & behoof forever in fee simple & the said William Lindsey
bearing the right true & proper owner of the above bargained land
will warrant & defend forever the same to the only proper use
& benefit of him the said Elijah Pullen & to his heirs & assigns for
