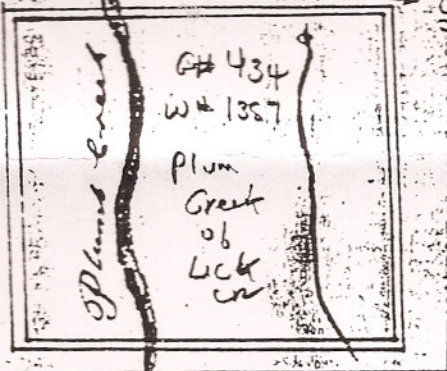

Wth 3^d Know ye that we have given and granted unto David Lindsey a tract of land containing four hundred acres lying and being in our County of Green, on the waters of Lick Creek and a creek called plumb creek. Beginning at a post Oak at Christians war path running West sixty six Chains and sixty six links to a hickory thence North sixty Chains to a stake thence East sixty six Chains and sixty six links to a dogwood thence North sixty Chains to the Beginning To Have to the said David Lindsey his heirs and assigns
