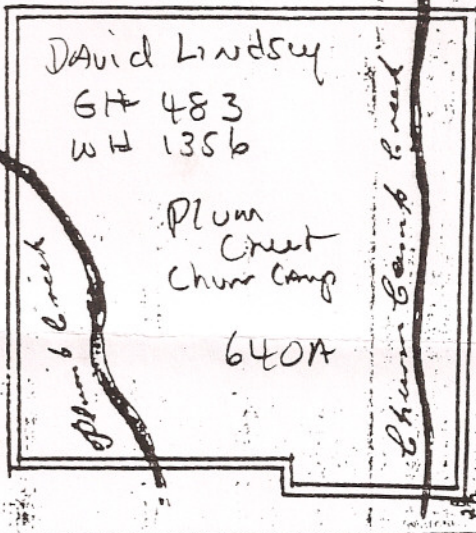

N^o 83 Know ye that we have given and granted unto David Lindsey a tract of land containing six hundred and forty acres lying and being in our county of Green, on plant creek and Churn Camp Creek, including his improvement, Beginning on a stake near browns path running west twenty eight chains and twenty five links to a hickory in a conditional line between said Lindsey and James Mitchell thence North five chains to a dogwood thence west fifty chains to a stake thence North eighty chains to a white Oak thence East seventy eight chains and twenty five links to a stake thence South eighty five chains to the Beginning. To have to the said David Lindsey his heirs and assigns forever Dated the 20th day of September 1787.
